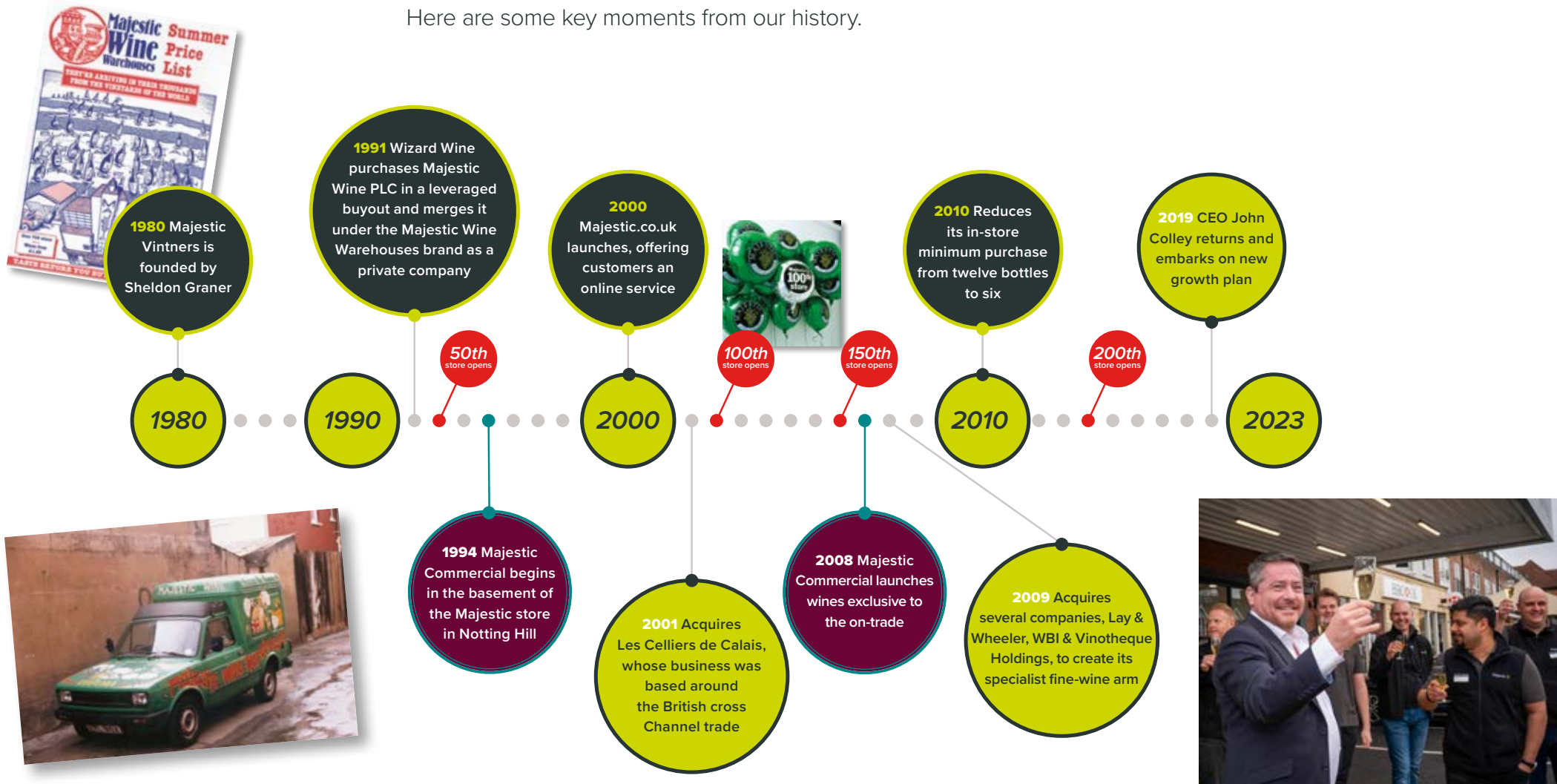

On the palate, the wine is full-bodied and elegant with the freshness of Chardonnay and richness of Pinot Noir. Overall, the wine is well-rounded with a fruity finish.

# Fizz

### Bouvet

In 1851, Etienne Bouvet and Celestine Ladubay purchased 8km of underground galleries in Saint-Hilaire-Saint-Florent. They later realised they were the perfect conditions to cellar wines. Just over 20 years later, they became the official fizz supplier to the British government. Today, Bouvet-Ladubay’s expertise lies in drawing out the subtle complexities of Chenin Blanc in delicious Crémant. Because of this, their fizz is often recommended as a great-value alternative to Champagne.
