NEW TREATMENTS FOR PAEDATRIC BRAIN TUMOURS





In May 2024, NICE approved the drugs dabrafenib and trametinib for the treatment of high & low grade paediatric gliomas. This treatment is now available on the NHS. The first new brain tumour treatment in decades.

This is transformative for children eligible for this treatment – instead of facing months in hospital undergoing chemotherapy, they can take medications at home

A NATIONAL BRAIN TUMOUR STRATEGY




With our open letter calling for a national brain tumour strategy gathering 52,000 signatures in just 6-weeks, we sent a message loud and clear to the government, the time to improve brain tumour care is now.

We have secured incredible support from parliamentarians and politicians from across the devolved nations supporting our call and demanding change.



MORE THAN DOUBLING THE CAPACITY OF OUR COUNSELLING SERVICE





We fill the gaps in diagnosis, treatment and care that the brain tumour community tell us need to be filled. We work in partnership with a wide range of healthcare professionals and other organisations to do this.

This year we focussed on increasing the capacity of our free counselling service. With the support of our volunteer professionals, we delivered 151% more counselling sessions than the previous year.
